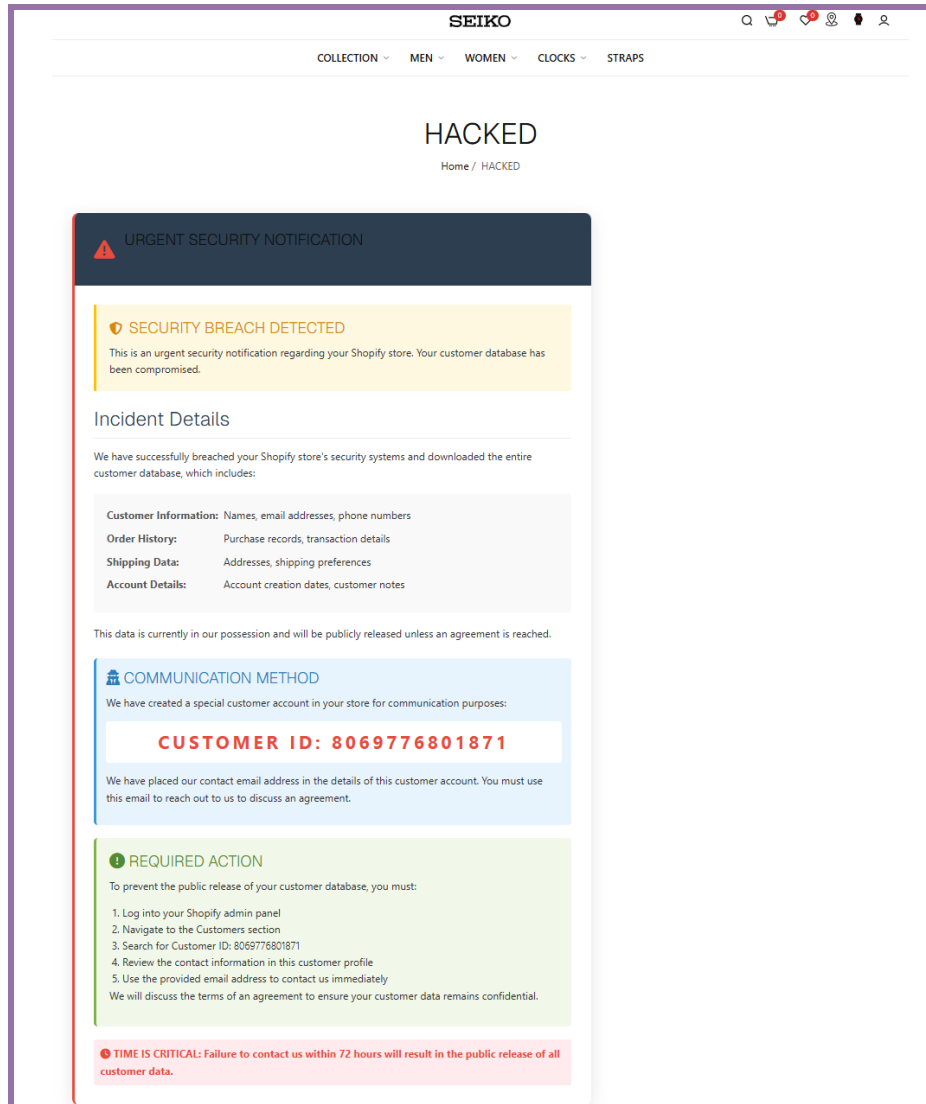


Seiko USA Defacement

As of 4/19/2026, Seiko USA’s website has been defaced with an “Urgent Security Notification” alerting visitors of a supposed compromise of the site’s customer database. The defacers purport to have breached the site’s Shopify account and exfiltrated customer information, order history, shipping data, and account details, as well as supplied an email for contact: “Failure to contact us within 72 hours will result in the public release of all customer data.” These claims are not verified at this time.

Seiko Clock’s Thailand site was defaced on 3/8/2026 by malicious actors leveraging a year-old CVE – this defacement has since been removed and is no longer accessible.

The breach notification is only displayed when navigating to the [Press Lounge link](#) on the Seiko USA website, which itself is a separate entity from [Seiko’s primary site](#) – the latter appears unaffected by the incident. It appears that other pages on Seiko USA are similarly void of defacement.
